



Churches Together in Teddington



Sacred Heart

Since 1882 the **Sacred Heart Church** has been the Catholic church in Teddington. It is located on Kingston Road opposite Langdon Park. Today we are a church with many nationalities in the congregation reflecting the diversity of London.

Our main service is the Mass. At weekends Mass is celebrated at 6.30pm Saturday evening and on Sunday morning at 9.30am and 11.15am.

At the 9.30 Mass we have the MASH (Music at Sacred Heart) Group who play a range of both modern and traditional spiritual music with keyboard, guitar, flute and violins.

At the 11.15am Mass we have a choir and organ adding a more traditional spiritual vitality.

We also have Mass every weekday morning at 9.30am except Fridays when there is a communion service.

The Parish of **St Francis de Sales** of Hampton Hill and Upper Teddington is situated in the Upper Thames Deanery. It was founded in 1920 and the original church was built in 1928. The new church was built in 1966 and consecrated on 18th Dec 1976.

St Mark's





Two Churches serving Teddington

Teddington 800 is a six month festival celebrating the 800th anniversary of the parish of Teddington. It is about sharing local heritage, celebrating our community togetherness, providing an ongoing legacy and commemorating steadfast Parish ministry.

St Mary with St Alban is the church standing on the original site selected in 1217. It is appropriate that it should be hosting the Songs of Praise held to celebrate this important festival. Our vision is to 'grow faith and friendship for all'. We seek to do this by engaging with people through our worship, our buildings, our partnerships, our learning, our fellowship and our communications. Sunday services are at 8am (Communion), 9am (All-age Morning Worship) and 10am (Parish Communion with Children's Groups). We also have a communion service followed by a mother and toddler Service on Wednesday mornings, a monthly Service of Wholeness & Healing on the first Thursday of the month, morning prayer on Tuesdays and Wednesdays and evening prayer every day except Monday. These incorporate a range of styles, both traditional and contemporary, so there's something for everyone.

The other church in this parish is **St Peter and St Paul**, based on the corner of Church Road and Broad Street. We share the vision and aspire to be soulful in our worship, open in our thinking about God and God's world, and prayerful about our place and purpose in Teddington. Do join us for our 9.45am. Sunday family communion with music band, morning prayer on Thursdays, one of our occasional courses, or simply contact the office to arrange a chat.

Teddington Baptist Church



Teddington Baptist Church is a family-centred welcoming church in Church Road. We have two services on Sundays at 10.30am and 6.30pm, both usually last an hour. In the morning service groups are available for children and young people, including a crèche and we welcome children with additional needs. Our evening service is usually quieter and more reflective. Every other month we hold a Teatime Special event for families at 3.30pm on a Sunday. We run groups for parents/carers and toddlers term time on Tuesday and Friday mornings at 10.00am and for dads and up to 7 year olds every third Saturday morning. Marriage, parenting, fathering and money management courses are regularly held and available to anyone. Our large premises are used daily for community purposes.

Teddington Methodist Church is located at 1, Stanley Road, Teddington –opposite the hospital. We are a friendly group of people from all walks of life, all ages, and from many different cultural and ethnic backgrounds. Our main Sunday service is a family service at 10.30am, lasting about an hour, with Junior Church for the 3 – 15s and a crèche for the under 3s. The style of the service is relatively traditional but relaxed with modern and traditional hymns, prayers, bible readings and a short sermon. Sunday evening services, normally at 6.30pm, are an opportunity for quiet reflection and on the 2nd Sunday of each month they are held at 4pm in Teddington Hospital Chapel.
